Working in the office, I have the opportunity to meet people who are all at different points along the continuum of faith. I am always amazed by the variety of experience and character that exists within the array of people who profess a faith in Christ.

One person, who has since gone on to eternity, who humbled me and kept me aware of my heart where giving is concerned is a woman who was homeless, and by worldly standards, had nothing – certainly nothing worth mentioning. Over the years I was privileged to help her with clothing needs, to be a listening ear in times of need, to offer guidance when appropriate, and to console her during times of loss.

Twice one week, as she often did, she came into my office and emptied her pockets of the few cents God had given her, saying she wanted to give it to “the church.” It reminds me of the story of the widow's mite that we find in Luke (vs. 1-4) when this woman, who had nothing, regularly gave all she had to further God's work in the community.

With this example in mind, let's all work to grow in our giving to God.
