GIVING TO GOD

From pastor Randy:

When we are giving to God, we learn to trust Him. He's promised that He'll meet our needs. But often we want stuff now – and God's timing might be different. But His timing is always perfect!

This Sunday we're focusing on the uniqueness of Jesus – that He is the only person who could ever be the sacrifice for the sins of the world. And He came at the perfect time – Galatians 4:4. That reminds me of the Old Testament time when God told Abraham to sacrifice his only son, Isaac – check out Genesis 22. Even though Abraham didn't understand why God wanted him to do that, he knew that he needed to obey God. Just as Abraham was ready to lower the knife, an angel from the Lord told him to stop, and that God had provided a ram for the offering – and Isaac's life was spared.

So God will come through, sometimes at the midnight hour. He allows us to learn to know Him more. So let's grow in our giving to God, and encourage each other with true stories of God's awesome provision.
